

Acousstop Comfy Panel Installation & Care Guide

1-Product Snapshot



Modular wall panels designed for noise control



Constructed of sound absorbing insulation membrane



Best acoustical performance; easy to clean & maintain



Humidity resistance, fire retardant, design flexibility



Multiple shade options



Customized sizes up to 2400mm and shapes available

2. Storage & Handling



Before You Start

- Keep panels flat on a clean, dry, level surface.
- Use protective layering (foam sheets or fabric) between panels to avoid scratches.
- Protect from moisture with moisture barrier or plastic sheets



Avoid Compression

- Don't stack too high to prevent compression or damage to acoustic performance
- Store in a temperature-controlled environment to prevent material degradation
- Stack horizontally depending on product shape and size to avoid bending or warping

3. Installation

Panels can be installed on walls only (not recommended for ceilings). Ensure the surface is clean, level, and dry before mounting.



Option A – Z-Profile

1. Mark level lines on the wall.
2. Fix Z-Profiles to the wall.
3. Engage each panel onto the Z-Profile.
4. Keep panel gaps consistent.



Option B – Velcro

1. Mark your layout on the wall.
2. Apply industrial Velcro strips to wall and panel.
3. Press panel firmly into place for full adhesion.

Note: Mounting methods depend on the product profile and project instructions. Follow site specifications for fixing hardware and spacing.

4. Care & Cleaning

Regular Maintenance

Use a soft brush attachment on a vacuum cleaner or lint roller weekly.

Spot Cleaning

Blot (don't rub) spills with a clean, damp cloth. Use mild soap and water for stains. Use professional fabric/upholstery cleaner if needed every few months.

What NOT to use

Avoid abrasive pads, bleach, ammonia, solvents, or high-pressure cleaning. Avoid cigarette smoke, heavy kitchen smoke, or moisture in enclosed spaces.

Environment

Use air purifiers or maintain good HVAC filters to minimize dust and pollutants. Avoid bumping or placing heavy items against panels. In high-traffic areas, consider protective corner guards or barriers.

5. Do's & Don'ts (Quick Reference)



Do

- Clean panels regularly (weekly dusting recommended).
- Use only soft brushes, vacuum attachments, or lint rollers.
- Use professional cleaning for commercial/large spaces periodically.
- Protect panels from physical impact.



Don't

- Use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- Expose to cigarette smoke, heavy kitchen smoke, or excessive moisture.
- Rub spills (blot instead).
- Bump or place heavy items against panels.
