2. Storage & Handling



Before You Start

- Store panels flat on clean, dry surface.
- Use protective material between panels.
- Keep in temperature-controlled, dry area.



Avoid Compression

- Don't stack higher than 800mm.

3. Installation

Install on walls or ceilings. Ensure surface is clean, level, and dry.



Option A – Suspension Hanging System

1. Install ceiling wires/rods.
2. Attach clips to panel edges.
3. Connect and level panels.
4. Adjust height per specifications.



Option B – Direct mounting with Screw on Primary Frame

1. Secure primary frame to surface.
2. Position panel.
3. Screw through panel into frame.
4. Conceal screw heads if desired.

Note: Panels can be installed on walls or ceilings. Ensure the surface is clean, level, and dry before mounting. Follow site specifications for fixing hardware and spacing.

4. Care & Cleaning

Regular Maintenance

Clean twice monthly with soft brush, microfiber cloth, or vacuum. Dust reduces sound absorption.

Spot Cleaning

Wipe gently with mild detergent.

What NOT to use

No abrasive pads, bleach, ammonia, solvents, or high-pressure cleaning.

Environment

Maintain 65-70% humidity. Keep HVAC filters clean. Avoid direct water contact.

5. Do's & Don'ts (Quick Reference)



Do

- Clean regularly (twice monthly).
- Use soft brushes/microfiber cloths.
- Maintain 65-70% humidity.
- Inspect fixings periodically.



Don't

- Use harsh chemicals or abrasives.
- Expose to water or high humidity.
- Apply high-pressure cleaning.
- Repaint panels.
