

# Acousstop Soft Baffles Installation & Care Guide

## 1-Product Snapshot



Modular wall panels designed for noise control.



Best acoustical performance; easy to clean & maintain.



Constructed of sound absorbing insulation membrane.



Fire rated (available on request); humidity resistance.



Fire retardant with design flexibility.



Multiple shade options; customized sizes up to 2400mm and shapes available.

## 2. Storage & Handling



### Before You Start

- Stack products on a clean, dry, and flat surface to prevent deformation.
- Use protective layering (foam sheets or fabric) between panels.
- Protect from moisture with barriers or plastic sheets.



### Avoid Compression

- Don't stack too high to prevent compression affecting acoustic performance.
- Store in a temperature-controlled environment.
- Stack horizontally to avoid bending or warping.

---

## 3. Installation

Soft baffles are installed on ceilings using suspension systems. Ensure the surface is clean, level, and dry before mounting.



### Suspension GI Wire Hanging System

1. Mark layout on ceiling.
2. Install GI wire suspension framework.
3. Attach baffles to suspension wires.
4. Ensure proper spacing and alignment.

**Note:** Mounting methods depend on the product profile and project instructions. Follow site specifications for fixing hardware and spacing.

## 4. Care & Cleaning

### Regular Maintenance

Dust weekly with soft brush vacuum attachment or lint roller.

### Spot Cleaning

Blot spills with damp cloth. Use mild soap for stains; professional fabric cleaner if needed.

### What NOT to use

Avoid rubbing, harsh chemicals, cigarette smoke, heavy kitchen smoke, or excessive moisture.

### Environment

Use air purifiers and maintain good HVAC filters. Avoid bumping or placing heavy items against panels.

## 5. Do's & Don'ts (Quick Reference)



### Do

- Dust panels weekly with soft tools.
- Blot spills immediately; use mild soap only.
- Maintain good air quality with filters/purifiers.
- Schedule professional cleaning for commercial spaces.



### Don't

- Use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Rub stains or expose to heavy smoke.
- Bump panels or place heavy items against them.
- Ignore dust buildup (reduces performance).
